

BIXBY MARSHLAND TOUR



Boy Scouts: Soil and Water Conservation badge

• This tour will fulfill the requirement to visit a wildlife refuge or a fish or game management area and observe soil and water conservation practices.



Cub Scouts: Bear Fur, Feathers and Ferns Adventure

• This tour allows the scouts to visit a wildlife refuge and identify signs of mammals, birds, insects, reptiles or plants living in the marshland.
